

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. Entries close the day before each show. Post entries accepted at no additional fee.
3. Prize money will be automatically deducted from entry fees.
4. Limited stabling with doors available @ \$15/stall/day; permanent stall \$20/stall/day. No tack stalls. No initial bedding.
5. Schooling available Friday from noon to 9:30 PM for horses and ponies entering the show. \$25 schooling fee if no entry is made. Ring will close at 8AM Saturday and Sunday.
6. There will be a \$5 insurance fee added to each entry.
7. At no time will ingate be held open for more than 2 minutes. **No exceptions.**
8. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes with 4 or fewer entries.
9. Entries must be paid in full or signed check left with secretary and membership proof presented before numbers will be issued. **No exceptions. \$25 fee for any checks returned by the bank.**
10. Life, senior active, and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Evening Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the advanced level, Dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Evening Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions, and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempt from the requirements of this rule: 1-leadline; 2-exhibitions; 3-games and races; 4-classes for 4H members; 5-walk,trot and academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6-USDF introductory level tests; pas de deux and quadrille classes; NRHA endorsed Reining Competitions; 8-Opportunity classes; 9-citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 8- USEA beginner novice division; and 9-assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
11. If 2 people share a horse, separate entries must be made and the applicable fees paid by each entry.
12. Indoor ring – sand footing – 190'x77'
13. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

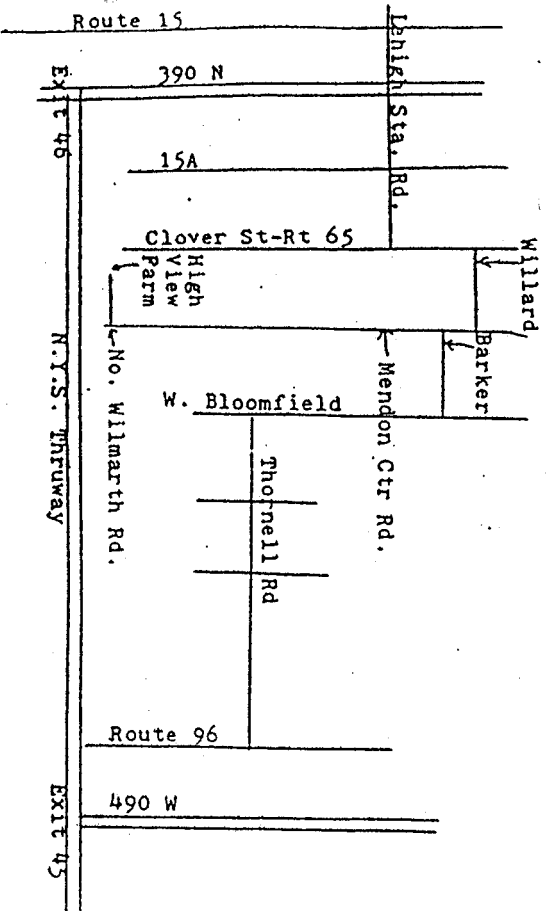

**SHORT STIRRUP** - Open to beginner junior riders who have not shown over 2'. Riders may not cross enter into any other PHA divisions or classes where fences exceed 2'. Riders may not have shown in any class where fences exceed 2'. Fences not to exceed 2'.
