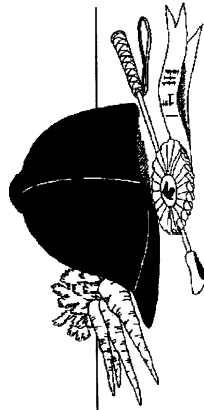
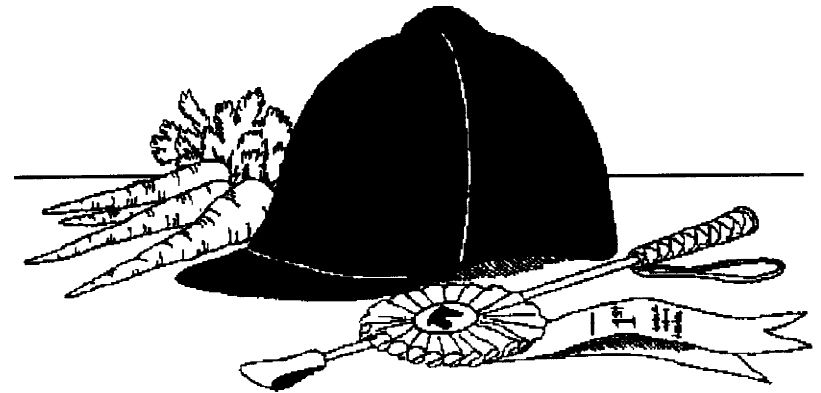

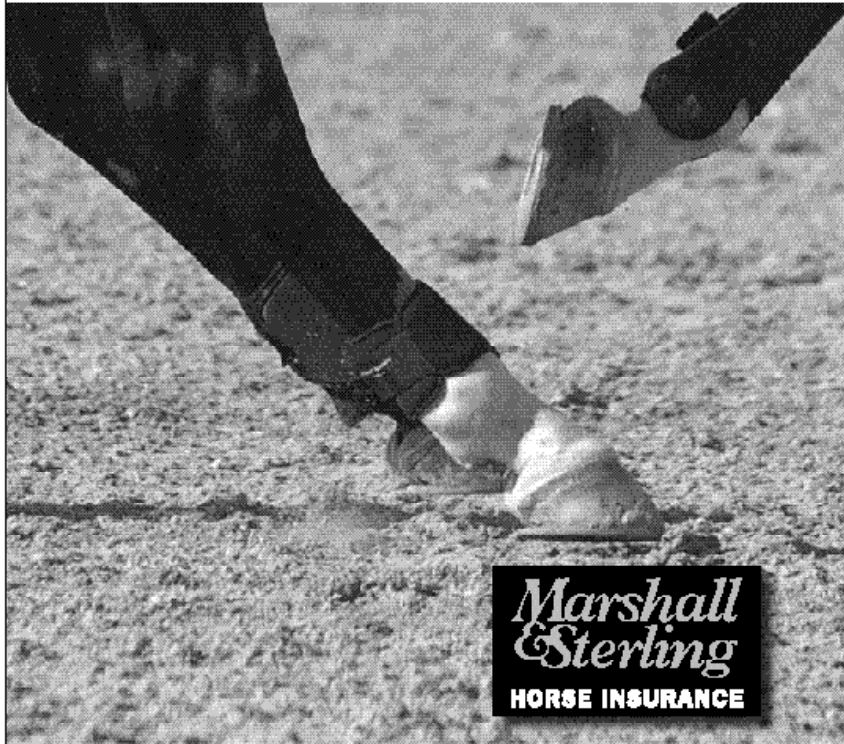

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. No person shall be allowed to ride in an Amateur Class who does not have a current USEF amateur certification or complete the appropriate paper work to apply for one in the show office. All Pony, Junior and Children's Pony Hunters must show current measurement cards or be measured at the show. **USEF and USHJA memberships available on line at www.usef.org. Post Entries Accepted At Regular Fees.**
3. USHJA #s or Horse Recording #s are required for all horses/ponies. USHJA #s are available for \$30 on the USEF website in advance of the show. **Print your proof of application. USHJA Horse #s may be applied for at the show.**
4. The management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show and to combine or cancel classes or divisions with fewer than four entries.
5. All prize money will be paid in the show office or credited to the exhibitor's bill.
6. There will be a \$30.00 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank. A billing charge of \$25.00 will be added to all accounts not settled in full at the show.
7. The indoor show ring is approximately 90' X 250' Indoor Schooling 60'X90' Both have sand and clay footing.
8. If Only Farm and the show manager take no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to horses, exhibitors, equipment and anyone connected thereto.
9. Each horse/rider is responsible for paying a \$35.00 EMT/Insurance Fee.
10. Schooling will be available prior to the start of the show. **A \$25.00 schooling fee will be charged if no entry is made.**
11. Full payment or a signed check must be left with the secretary before numbers are issued.
12. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. **Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the advanced level, Dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the advanced level, Dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk/trot and academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes. 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. EC 7/21/08 Effective 12/1/08**
13. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
14. All dogs must be restrained on a leash at all times.
15. Exhibitors must be prepared to produce a Negative Coggins Test and Proof of a Rabies Vaccination for each horse/pony.

RULES GOVERNING THE AWARDS

1. To be eligible for High Score Awards, all horses and ponies must be nominated and the person(s) in whose name(s) the horse or pony is showing, or the child who is showing in horsemanship classes, must be a current member of the Syracuse Chapter PHA. No points will count towards the High Score Awards until after the dues and nominations are received by the PHA Secretary.

2. THE SYRACUSE PHA MEDAL EQUITATION CLASSES

Unless noted otherwise, all classes to be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles, which may include one combination including an oxer and one change of direction. Fences for Junior Hunter Riders 3'6"; fences for Children's Hunters Horses and Adult Riders 3'; fences for Children's Hunters Ponies not to exceed 3" less than required height for smallest pony. USEF Tests for Junior Hunter Riders 1-19; Children's Hunters and Adult Riders 1-13; Children's Ponies 1-9. Testing is optional in all classes and/or the Judge may elect to include one or more tests in the original course. Competition is open to all riders, but in order for points to count toward the year end awards, membership must be received by the PHA Secretary prior to the start of the show. Every Syracuse PHA Member show is required to offer a separate Junior, Children's and Adult PHA Medal Class if they offer the corresponding Hunter Divisions. If show management desires, it may elect to substitute the National PHA Medal Equitation Class for the 3'6" Section of the Syracuse Medal. Winners will receive points toward both awards. However, if the National class does not fill, the class must still be run as a Syracuse PHA Medal class. Management may elect to offer a separate class for riders of Children's Hunter Ponies. Horses and riders showing in the Junior Hunter Division, may not enter the Children's Medal at the same show. Children's Pony riders may enter the USEF Pony Medal also. **Additional rules explained in the current Syracuse PHA Rule Book.**

3. PRE-GREEN HUNTERS

Open to all horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing that have never shown in classes where the fences exceed 3'3" at Regular Member USEF or Equine Canada Horse Shows and/or PHA Rated Divisions. Horses may not show in any classes at this show where the fences exceed 3'3".

All Hunter Classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

In Hunter Under Saddle Classes horses are shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth required. Horses should be obedient, alert, responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judges may ask horses to hand gallop collectively, one way of the ring in Junior, Amateur-Owner & Pony Hunter Classes. No more than eight entries may be asked to hand gallop at one time. To be eligible for Under Saddle Classes in any A or B rated divisions animals must be entered in at least one over fences class in the same division.

Championships awarded in all hunter sections in accordance with USEF Rules.

Adult Amateur Hunter: To be shown by riders who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors, in possession of current USEF Amateur Certification. Ponies may be shown by Adults, suitability to count. Fences not to exceed 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3", except Adult Amateur Jumper. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at the same competition. Horses may be jogged for soundness at the discretion of the judge.

Children's Hunter: To be shown by junior exhibitors. Fences height to be 3' for horses; 2' for small and medium ponies; 2'6" for large ponies; spreads not to exceed fence heights. Riders may cross enter in unrated classes, equitation classes not to exceed 3'6", and Children's Jumpers up to Level 4. Horses and ponies may cross enter only in unrated classes, Equitation classes not to exceed 3'6", Adult Amateur Hunters, and First Year Green and Second Year Green Hunters, if otherwise eligible. FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State Of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. (GR 908.4)

Federation Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in the **If Only Farm Horse Show** to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaultor, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.
