- **FROM DOWNTOWN BUFFALO**
Travel South over the Skyway on Route 5 to Milestrip Road (Route 179) East. At the fourth light make a right onto McKinley Parkway. Enter the Fairgrounds at Delivery Gate B, the most southern entrance to the Fair.
- **FROM THE THRUWAY (I-90)**
(Coming from Amherst, Rochester, Syracuse or Pennsylvania)
Take exit 56 (Blasdell/Milestrip). Make a left onto Milestrip Road (Route 179). At the second light, make a right hand turn on to McKinley Parkway. Enter the Fairgrounds at Delivery Gate B, the most southern entrance to the Fair.
- **FROM BOSTON OR SPRINGVILLE**
Travel North on the 219 Expressway. Take Boston Exit. Make a left on to Route 391. Turn right onto McKinley Parkway and enter at Delivery Gate B, first gate after Clark Street.

**2006 FAIR SEASON
ANIMAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**

I. ALL ANIMALS – GENERAL COMMENTS

All animals must be free from any signs of contagious disease. Examples of contagious diseases for which animals have been denied entry or rejected from fairs include the following: ringworm, warts, mange, sore mouth, respiratory infections, and contagious hoof infections.

Animal health documents approved at one fair will be accepted for review at all other fairs during the same calendar year. Regardless of previous fair admission history, when documents are presented for review, health status of each animal, and recent disease exposure will be evaluated before admission to the fairgrounds is allowed.

Animal Identification – Animals must be uniquely identified. Acceptable identification allows positive matching of the animal to all accompanying documents, including papers with laboratory test results and vaccination statements. If a sketch or photograph is to be used for official identification of an animal, the sketch or photograph must contain the signature of the attending veterinarian and date. Horse sketches and descriptions should reference color pattern, hair whorls, chestnuts, scars and other markings. Llama drawings, as for horses, must positively identify the individual animal. A name or a statement of color without additional distinguishing features or man made identification is not acceptable identification.

Follow Drug and Vaccine Withholding Times – In order to prevent the contamination of food products, labeled withholding times should be strictly adhered to in food producing animals that have been treated with any chemical (drug) or have had vaccine administered.

Proof of Vaccination – A signed, written statement from the attending veterinarian is required as proof of vaccination. A valid animal health certificate which has the vaccination(s) listed and is signed by the issuing veterinarian is acceptable proof of vaccination.

II. **RABIES VACCINATION** – Proof of rabies vaccination **will be required at all** fairs for those species that a USDA licensed vaccine is available (cattle, cats, dogs, horses, ferrets and sheep). Proof of vaccination must include the signature of the veterinarian. The vaccine must be administered at the Erie County Fair entrance requirements include veterinary documentation of rabies vaccination. At the time of printing, approved rabies vaccine at least 14 days prior to arrival on the fairgrounds but no greater than the labeled time specified for active protection against rabies. The animal's rabies vaccination status must remain current throughout its stay on the fairgrounds. Rabies vaccination of all other mammalian species is strongly recommended. This requirement applies to BOTH New York State and Non New York State Animals.

III. CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION

NON-New York State Animals: All animals entering New York State must satisfy import health and test requirements for that species. The interstate CVI is valid for 30 days from the date of issuance with regard to entrance into New York State.

IV. HORSES (Equidae) LIVESTOCK REQUIREMENTS:

a. Equine Infectious Anemia Test (EIA/Coggins) – a valid EIA chart documenting that the animal has been tested (any USDA approved test) within the current or previous calendar year (2005 and 2006 for this fair season), and found to be negative for EIA infection, is required of all equines 6 months of age and older. The animal identification noted on all accompanying documents must match the description on the official EIA chart. NOTE: “No Markings” is not acceptable identification.

b. Rabies Vaccination – Proof of active immunization against rabies required.

ALL HORSES OVER 6 MONTHS OF AGE MUST HAVE BEEN IMMUNIZED AGAINST RABIES AT LEAST 14 DAYS PRIOR TO ENTRY TO THE GROUNDS. PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION MUST INCLUDE THE DATE OF ADMINISTRATION AND THE TYPE OF VACCINE USED.

WE REQUEST YOU SEND A PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR COGGINS AND RABIES CERTIFICATES ALONG WITH YOUR ENTRIES TO SPEED UP PROCESSING.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Exhibitors Are Responsible For Knowledge Of Show Rules

This show is held under the current rules and specifications of USEF and their rules will govern, except that the rules and regulations of the AMERICA'S FAIR Horse Show shall take precedence where there is any conflict and the decision of the show management shall be final. The America's Fair Horse Show reserves the right to amend or change the rules, officials and/or show staff at any time prior to the show, and give due notice to the exhibitors of any changes.

1. All exhibitor packets, numbers, groom and parking passes that were not mailed out may be obtained upon arrival at the HORSE SHOW OFFICE located at the end of Ring 1 in the Grooms Quarters. STABLING assignments may be obtained from the Stabling Manager upon arrival.
2. ENTRY INFORMATION: ENTRIES CLOSE TUESDAY, AUGUST 1, 2006. All entries postmarked and PAID by August 1, 2006 will be accepted at the regular entry fees. All entries postmarked after August 1, 2006 will be considered a post entry and will be charged a late fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per horse. Any payments returned as NSF will incur a \$39.00 penalty. Incomplete entries are subject to a penalty not to exceed \$25.00 per horse.
3. All entries must be made by the exhibitor or his authorized agent, and no animal will be admitted or exhibited unless the entry form is duly signed and presented to the secretary. NY State requires a PHOTOCOPY of negative Coggins test and rabies vaccination certificate on each horse be submitted with your entry form. Management reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry fees before or during the show without being liable.
4. Only one horse allowed on each entry form. Please make copies of both sides of the appropriate forms or call for additional forms.
5. Every owner must pay the \$15.00 exhibitor fee or \$50.00 Erie County Agricultural Society Membership fee.
6. REFUND POLICY – Refund requests received prior to the closing date of entries will receive a full refund including stall fees. Requests received after the closing date of entries, but prior to the start of the show, will receive a complete refund less \$20.00 per horse. Refund requests received after the show begins will receive a complete refund of all fees paid except stabling charges. Stabling fees will not be refunded after the show begins for any reason. Vet certificates are not required for any refund.
7. Prize Money: All prize money in excess of balances due will be mailed to the owner of record, unless otherwise directed, within 15 days of the completion of the show. PREMIUM CHECKS NOT CASHED BY NOVEMBER 30 of the current year SHALL BE FORFEITED TO THE SOCIETY.
8. Any exhibitor entering the show ring with no number or an incorrect number will not be judged. Any horse shown in a class for which it has not been properly entered will be charged DOUBLE entry fee.
9. The Society and the Horse Show committee will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any person or exhibitor, or to any animal or vehicle exhibited at the AMERICA'S FAIR HORSE SHOW.
10. To be eligible to show in performance championship classes, a horse must have been entered, shown and judged in one qualifying class in the same division or section.
11. All youth staying on the grounds, either as exhibitors or guests of horsemen, must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
12. FOOTING – The footing used in all show rings and warm up areas is washed sand. The dimensions of the competition arenas are as follows:
Ring 1 – 143' x 254' Ring 2 – 112' x 290'
13. NO PETS ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.
14. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, COMBINED TRAINING/EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL OR ABOVE, DRESSAGE AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES PROVIDED THE RESPECTIVE BREED/DISCIPLINE DUES OR BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE HAS BEEN PAID. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, COMBINED TRAINING/EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$15. NON-MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE AND A \$5 BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE FOR EACH BREED/DISCIPLINE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES. ALSO EXEMPTED FROM THIS REQUIREMENT ARE RESIDENTS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO ARE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR NATIONAL FEDERATION, AND 7) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES; AND (8) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO ARE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR NATIONAL FEDERATIONS AND, IN THE CASE OF RIDERS, DRIVERS OR VAULTERS COMPETING IN DISCIPLINES RECOGNIZED BY THE FEI, IN POSSESSION OF A FOREIGN COMPETITOR'S LICENSE TO COMPETE IN NATIONAL COMPETITIONS, WHICH HAS BEEN ISSUED BY THE FEDERATION.

15. Competition Management will fine any individuals including trainers, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.
16. There will be no manual poling or use of bamboo offsets permitted at any time.

CAMPER PARKING

Camper parking must be requested on the entry form. Payment must accompany requests. Camper stickers will be AVAILABLE UPON ARRIVAL. All camper spaces include electric hookups only. Spaces will be accommodated in two locations; in the Horse Show Camper Lot, (For trailers in this area all tow vehicles MUST be removed). In the Grey Lot, which is located behind Ring II, tow vehicles may remain attached. Spaces will be allocated on a first-come basis by the Lot Manager. Any changes must be approved by the Horse Show Manager. Horse trailers, passenger vehicles, vans without factory installed living quarters, etc. will NOT be allowed in camper areas. In the event sufficient camper parking is not available in the stabling area, management reserves the right to assign campers to another area on the grounds.

Camper units will have a waste water pumping service available on August 16th for a fee of \$20 per service. The pumping service must be paid for at the horse show office, at that time the paid customer will receive a tag to place in their window to signify they need to be serviced.

CAMPER LOT RULES

At the direction of the New York State Department of Health and in order to maintain our operating permit, the following regulations must be implemented and adhered to at all times.

1. A five (5) foot separation between each unit MUST be maintained on all sides. (This is measured from the furthest extremity, slide out or other apparatus.)
2. NO awnings are allowed in the down position. This includes canvas rooms.
3. NO bonfires/campfires.
4. NO open flames of any type, including propane grills, charcoal, cook stoves, etc.
5. Outside cooking is permitted in designated areas only AND must be a minimum of twenty-five (25) feet from any structure or unit.
6. All units MUST have a fire extinguisher or method of fire protection available.
7. DO NOT block the roadways with personal vehicles.
8. Maintain ALL FIRE LANES at ALL times.
9. Speed limit is 5 mph.
10. NO gray water dumping (a scavenger service is available, contact the Park Manager in your area).

Failure to comply with regulations will result in loss of privileges and immediate removal of the unit.

Any questions should be directed to the designated Manager in the area.

EXHIBITOR PARKING & PASSES

Exhibitors not purchasing Preferred Parking will be issued a complimentary parking pass for the Grey Lot located behind Ring II for passenger vehicles only.

Exhibitors purchasing Preferred Parking will be issued VIP stickers, which allows inside fairgrounds parking in a reserved lot located on the South end of Barn 12C.

VIP PARKING (Limited Spaces) \$50.00

PASSENGER VEHICLES ONLY IN VIP LOT

Parking stickers will be AVAILABLE UPON ARRIVAL and WILL NOT BE REPLACED IF LOST OR STOLEN. No telephone requests for parking will be honored. All parking requests will be made on the entry form.

Exhibitor passes will be AVAILABLE UPON ARRIVAL. A temporary admittance letter will be mailed to the trainer as listed on the entry blank.

HORSE VEHICLE PARKING

A parking area has been established for horse trailer and horse transport vehicles. There is no charge for parking in this area. All vehicles are to be parked in the designated parking lot outside the fairgrounds fence. NO PARKING NEAR THE HORSE BARN.

No points will count towards the High Score Awards until after the dues and nominations are received by the PHA Secretary.

2. THE SYRACUSE PHA MEDAL EQUITATION CLASSES

Unless noted otherwise, all classes to be shown over a course of not less than 6 obstacles, which may include one combination including an oxer and one change of direction. Fences for Junior Hunter Riders 3'6"; fences for Children's Hunters Horses and Adult Riders 3'; fences for Children's Hunters Ponies not to exceed 3" less than required height for smallest pony. USEF Tests for Junior Hunter Riders 1-19; Children's Hunters and Adult Riders 1-13; Children's Ponies 1-9. Testing is optional in all classes and/or the Judge may elect to include one or more tests in the original course. Competition is open to all riders, but in order for points to count toward the year end awards, membership must be received by the PHA Secretary prior to the start of the show. Every Syracuse PHA Member show is required to offer a separate Junior, Children's and Adult PHA Medal Class if they offer the corresponding Hunter Divisions. If show management desires, it may elect to substitute the National PHA Medal Equitation Class for the 3'6" Section of the Syracuse Medal. Winners will receive points toward both awards. However, if the National class does not fill, the class must still be run as a Syracuse PHA Medal class. Management may elect to offer a separate class for riders of Children's Hunter Ponies. Horses and riders showing in the Junior Hunter Division, may not enter the Children's Medal at the same show.
