All Hunter Classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

In Hunter Under Saddle Classes horses are shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horses mouth is required. Horses should be should be obedient, alert, responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Judges may ask horses to hand gallop one way of the ring in Junior, Pony, Regular, and Amateur-Owner classes, but no more than eight to gallop at one time. Martingales are not permitted.

Courses: will simulate fences found in the hunt field such as brush, wall, in and out, oxer, post and rails, gate and panels. Management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads as conditions and competition warrants.

Championships will be awarded in all Hunter sections in accordance with USEF rules.
